

## Capitalisation 2008-09 (Excluding Equal Pay): Late Applications

The conditions for applying for capitalisation directions in 2008-09 were included in the published guidance. This set a deadline of 15 December 2008 for the submission of applications for non-equal pay capitalisation. The guidance made clear that, under exceptional circumstances, applications for the current financial year received after the closing date would be considered on or after the 31 January, and in considering any applications received after that date, CLG would take account of the level of capitalisation which had already been reached and the potential threat to the Government's fiscal rules presented by issuing further directions in a financial year. Decisions on all applications received by the 15 December deadline were announced on 30 January 2009.

Details of all the late applications received are below, together with the decisions.
